Basic Bible – The Gospel of John and Hebrews

Basic Bible is a study suited for all ladies, regardless of familiarity with the Bible. This study will teach the arrangement of the books of the Bible, enable the hearing of the Word by reading it aloud and allow the Word to speak as passages are reviewed together. Do you sincerely want to study the Bible on your own but just don't know how? The purpose of this study is to give you some simple step-by-step instructions on how to study the Word of God. You will learn 12 methods for exploring the Bible and applying the riches of God's Word to your life. We will study a variety of passages, character qualities, and people as well as focusing in on the book of Colossians. Come and join our community as we delve into the treasures of the Word of God. Class time will involve learning each study method and sharing of what each of us learned in our own study that week. Our teaching resource is Rick Warren's "Bible Study Methods: 12 Ways You Can Unlock God's Word" (Rick Warren is the author of "The Purpose Driven Life"). Homework will vary from 20 min-2 hours per week depending on the method and passage of the week. Registration and Book Fee: \$35

We all have ideas we tell ourselves about God and how He works in our lives. Some are true – many are false. Those thoughts determine not only who we are, but also how we live. Throughout this semester we will put your ideas to the test to see if they match up with what Jesus Himself reveals about God. Once you've discovered the truth in Scripture, you can engage in a process of spiritual formation that includes specific activities aimed at making these new narratives real in your body and soul as well as your mind. Together we will discover the narratives that Jesus lived by – to know the Lord He knew and the kingdom He proclaimed – and we will practice the spiritual exercises that will help us grow in our knowledge of our good and beautiful God.
